

2. Get the Most Modern .NET CMS on the Market

Ektron built its CMS interface on old Microsoft ASP.NET technology: Web Controls. This alone locked you into the MS roadmap for your front-end, with no flexibility at all. And if you customized those Web Controls? If Microsoft updated the Web Controls and you installed the updates, your interface would break.

Ingeniux completely rewrote its CMS software using the latest version of Microsoft .NET. Ingeniux CMS is built to support Microsoft's MVC (Model, View, Control) approach to .NET development. It supports the Razor View Engine, which is a much easier, and web standards-friendly, development approach. You don't have to worry about the overhead and legacy of Web Forms development.

Ingeniux is built on an agile architecture.
You can create your complete web
experience within the Ingeniux
environment, or you can build your frontend using a completely different technology.
If you want to provide content management
capabilities for your web applications or
mobile apps, Ingeniux provides contentas-a-service, giving you management
and governance of your content and the

flexibility to deploy it to multiple delivery channels, regardless of the technology that delivery channel is built on.

With a mobile-first architecture, Ingeniux provides a responsive visual template and web page tool called Page Builder. Page Builder enables technical and non-technical users to visually create templates that are automatically mobile-friendly.

3. Easier Upgrades

Most implementations of Ektron resulted in tightly coupled presentation and content administration. In many cases, these websites required customization of the Ektron application. This customization resulted in complex and painful upgrades, which meant that often, the upgrades weren't applied at all.

Ingeniux, on the hand, is decoupled.
There is a complete separation of the presentation layer from the backend content administration. Decoupled CMS products have dramatically easier upgrades because they don't require you to modify the product code to implement the website. This means that when the Ingeniux CMS is upgraded, your websites are not affected, saving you countless headaches, as well as time and money.



4. Built-in Synchronization

Ektron does provide a content synchronization option – e-Sync.
Unfortunately, e-Sync was a premium addon, so you had to pay to keep your content synchronized. To make it worse, you had to install the e-Sync feature on each server where you had content.

Ingeniux provides native synchronization so you can easily keep your content updated across locations. With Ingeniux CMS, you do not need to install a full copy of the software on every instance in your network. Content is delivered using a lightweight .NET application.

5. Designed to Integrate

Ektron does provide integrations with thirdparty applications, but they are proprietary and closed.

Ingeniux offers built-in integration with key marketing automation and CRM providers, as well as eCommerce providers. In each case, the source code is included. The Ingeniux integration model is easy to understand and includes a 100% public REST API and a native .NET API, all fully documented.

6. Easy migration using Ingeniux Site Import Utility

Need to get your content out of Ektron? No problem. Ingeniux includes a Site Import Utility that lets you map and import your content into Ingeniux CMS.

Ingeniux provides a flexible database model based on NoSQL. This allows Ingeniux to pull in content from the Ektron database or consume Ektron websites as HTML and modify them once they are in Ingeniux. The Site Import Utility also supports Ektron's asset structure so you can migrate all content and metadata.

7. Built-In Enterprise Search

If you wanted search with your Ektron implementation, you typically integrated a third-party search engine. While that's not completely bad, what was frustrating was that Ektron had no native content model awareness, so all you could do was full-text indexing.

Compare that to Ingeniux, which does integrate with third-party search engines, but also provides a native search engine. Ingeniux provides a search-based

architecture that enables you to leverage search throughout your website, from basic searching, to faceted and guided search, to recommendations and search-based navigation. In addition, Ingeniux search is security aware and globalized so you can search regardless of language. And, if you have a lot of content, Ingeniux search is ultra-high-scale, up to tens of millions of content items.

8. Lower TCO

Ektron might have seemed a cost-effective CMS when you purchased it, but multiple required add-ons soon added to the cost. Add to that painful upgrades that usually resulted in expensive re-implementations and your TCO went through the roof.

Ingeniux has a much better TCO. It provides easier upgrades that take under thirty minutes. It is API driven, and you don't need a DBA to manage the database. Also, Ingeniux is built for the Cloud, so you can go with a managed solution that significantly cuts your costs.

You also save on content administration in a number of ways. In Ingeniux it takes less time to manage the little - but-important - things such as redirects (they are automatic) and linking (also automatic).
